- Stress Incontinence
 - Laughing, sneezing, coughing, exercising, lifting and having sex
 - Caused by a weak sphincter and/or pelvic muscle support

Urge Incontinence

- Bladder squeezes without your control
- Often associated with extreme urgency & frequency
- Caused by an "overactive bladder" aka "sensitive bladder"

- Mixed Incontinence
 - Urge and leak
 - Sneeze and leak



Overflow Incontinence

 The bladder doesn't empty fully, causing urine to spill out at odd times

Transient Incontinence

- Due to a medical condition or its treatment, a person temporarily develops a leaky bladder.
- Severe constipation, irritated bladder, diuretic medication, sleeping pills, pain medications and post-surgery (anesthesia, immobility).

- Functional Incontinence
 - Due to physical or mental limitations, a person doesn't reach the bathroom quickly enough.
 - Seniors with arthritis, Parkinson's disease,
 dementia or Alzheimer's disease may have this
 type of incontinence.

- Total Incontinence
 - When serious conditions disrupt the normal channels and processes of voiding, complete loss of bladder control may result
 - Fistulas and nerve-related problems such as spinal cord injuries and multiple sclerosis




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


Diagnostic Tests

- Voiding Diary
- Belly and Pelvic or Prostate Exam
- Bladder Ultrasound (picture of the bladder)
- Cystoscopy (camera to peek into the bladder)
- Urine Flow test (check the speed of flow)
- Urodynamics (ultimate bladder function test)







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
Medical Treatments


- Pills
 - "calm" the bladder urge
 - help men and some women empty their bladder better
 - Help the bladder squeeze better to empty better
- Botox injections
- Nerve stimulators
- Pessary / Poise Impressa

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Poise Impressa
Bladder Supports
can be worn for up
to 8 hours in a 24hour period to help
prevent leaks






Surgical Treatments

- Bladder slings or "lifts" are surgeries that help in leaks with coughing/sneezing
- Multiple prostate procedures that help with urinary obstruction of flow
- Artificial sphincter surgery

Artificial Urinary Sphincter



Lifestyle Changes

- Fluid management
- Constipation treatment
- Medications (diuretics, pain meds, sinus/allergy)
- Physical Therapy
- Pelvic Exercises Kegels
- Scheduled Urination, "Double-voiding"

- Leaky bladders are a definite problem that may affect a person's quality of life
